## UWC of South East Asia Class of '78 raise a scholarship.

At the Class of '78 30-year reunion last year, several UWCSEA graduates decided to embark on a project that allowed the class to 'give something back', setting the ambitious target of funding a full two-year scholarship. In four months the target was reached with S\$60,000 (approx US\$41,500) of gifts and pledges received from 34 graduates. This has funded a scholarship for a student from Kenya, who joins UWCSEA in September 2009.

Dave Shepherd, Director of Advancement at the College says "The Foundation would like to thank the entire class for their encouragement. Whilst this was certainly an inclusive project, I am sure the class would echo our sincere thanks to Dale Fisher (SEA 76-78) who drew the group together for this project since the idea was first discussed. We are hoping it will inspire subsequent classes to make gifts at their 30-year reunions and we also hope that each class gift will stay in perpetuity. The classes of '79 and '80 are already discussing how they would like to support the College."
